## Dates

Belmont’s Talent Show will be on Saturday, May 4, 2019 at Sherwood High School. We will have one show on **May 4, 2019 at 3:00 PM.**

## How to Sign-Up?

1. Organize your group/act and decide what talent you are going to perform for the show.
2. We will be using Google Forms to register the groups. Please fill out the Google Form with all of your groups information. If you are having difficulty registering through Google Forms, please email us at [belmontsgottalent01@gmail.com](mailto:belmontsgottalent01@gmail.com).
  - a. Name of your song/act
  - b. If you are using a song (Name of the artist or band)
  - c. If you are doing a Mashup of songs, we need all of the songs listed.
  - d. Name of your group’s contact person/phone number/email address.

3. An email will be sent letting you know that your song choice has been confirmed.
4. Song choices will be approved on a first come basis.
5. The deadline to register is **March 5th**.

**Music** Maximum of 2 minutes and 20 seconds

If your act includes recorded music, you must provide a cut CD or email us the music. Your musical selection should be cut/faded to meet the maximum time requirements of 2 minutes and 20 seconds or less. Please be thoughtful in your music selection as it needs to be appropriate for all listening ages. If you have to edit your song for inappropriate language, please rethink your choice of music. Music will be requested prior to the Practice Day.

**Costumes**

Please make sure that costumes are appropriate for an Elementary School event. Please hold onto receipts just in case costume changes need to be made.

**Props**

Please keep props to a minimum. All props need to be approved by the committee.

**Practices and Dress Rehearsals**

All groups must attend all at-school practices and dress rehearsals, with the exception of illness.

**Practice at Belmont – April 3, 2019**

At this practice time, your group will have the opportunity to practice in a large space at Belmont. These practice times give your act a chance to get familiar with the stage, learn to position yourselves on the stage and polish your act. Yearbook pictures are taken at this time. Your Practice time will be scheduled through Sign-Up Genius.

## **Dress Rehearsal - May 3rd @ Sherwood**

The day before the show opens, we practice going through the entire show from start to finish. All acts are in costume and use their props. Groups usually take photos at this time, so please don't forget full hair and makeup too.

### **Parent Volunteers**

1. Parent Volunteer Requirements
  - a. Groups of 2 children or less, need 1 adult to volunteer.
  - b. Groups of 3-5 children need 2 adults to volunteer.
  - c. Groups with 6-10 children need 4 adults to volunteer.
  - d. Groups with 11+ children need 5 adults to volunteer.

We will send out the Sign-up Genius through email. Volunteer Positions include; ticket sellers, concessions, green room helpers, auditorium helpers, plus much more. We are also in need of Committee Members to help run the show.

### **5th Grade Sign-Up**

1. All 5th graders can participate in the 5th grade dance.
2. If your child is an MC, they cannot be in another act with the exception of the 5th grade dance.
3. If your child is an MC, please be prepared to help with the script and practices.
4. Please use the 5th grade Google Form to sign-up your child to be an MC and/or the 5th grade dance.
5. If your child is in another act, you will need to fill out the sign-up Google form for their act and the 5th grade Google form to sign them up to be in the 5th grade dance.
6. We will be having a brief meeting (Date TBT) to answer any questions you may have.
